

COVID-19 Guidelines for IN PERSON SERVICES

- You must practice self-screening. If you, or any one in your household, are not feeling well or have been exposed to Covid-19 please stay at home.
- Please observe social distancing of 2m upon entering the church and while inside the church building.
- Families from the same household need to sit together in a row. Members of separate households are required to sit in every other row. Please remain in place once you are seated.
- Every other row will be roped off, please do not sit in these rows.
- Hand sanitizer will be available. Please use the hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving the building (or outdoor seating area).
- If you need to cough or sneeze do this into your elbow or a tissue.
- You are strongly encouraged to wear a mask.
- Children are welcome, but they need to remain with their parents at all times.
- We will not have any congregational singing.
- There will be no coffee or lemonade time.
- The offering plate will not be available. Please continue to give your offering electronically or through the mail.
- If you attend a service and subsequently develop any symptoms, please call the church office so that others who were also in attendance can monitor their symptoms.
- A reminder that those with underlying medical conditions and those over 65 years of age are at a higher risk of experiencing worse symptoms than others contracting the virus.
- Please use the washroom at home. The washrooms will be available for emergencies only.
