

COVID-19 Guidelines for IN PERSON SERVICES

General	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you attend a service and subsequently develop any symptoms, please call the church office so that others who were also in attendance can monitor their symptoms.• You must practice self-screening. If you, or any one in your household, are not feeling well or have been exposed to Covid-19 please stay at home.• Please use the washroom at home. The washrooms will be available for emergencies only.• If you need to cough or sneeze do this into your elbow or a tissue.
When you Arrive	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hand sanitizer will be available. Please use the hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving the building (or outdoor seating area).
In the Sanctuary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You are strongly encouraged to wear a mask.• Families from the same household need to sit together in a row. Members of separate households are required to sit in every other row. Please remain in place once you are seated.• Children are welcome, but they need to remain with their parents at all times.• Please observe social distancing of 2m upon entering the church and while inside the church building.• We will not have any congregational singing.• Every other row will be roped off, please do not sit in these rows.• The offering plate will not be available. Please continue to give your offering electronically or through the mail.
